# Setting up TERIA NTRIP network

#### Software:

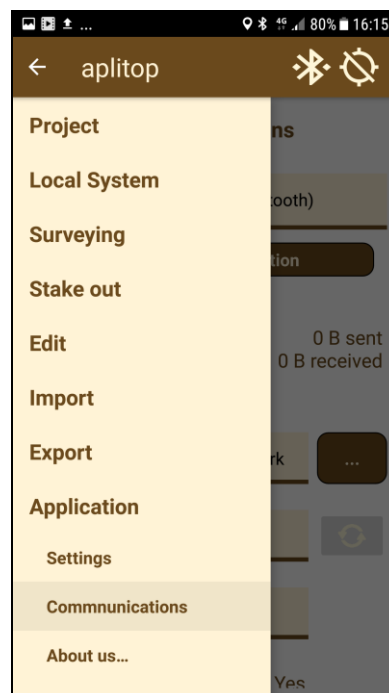
TcpGPS v1.0.5+ for Android

### Objetive

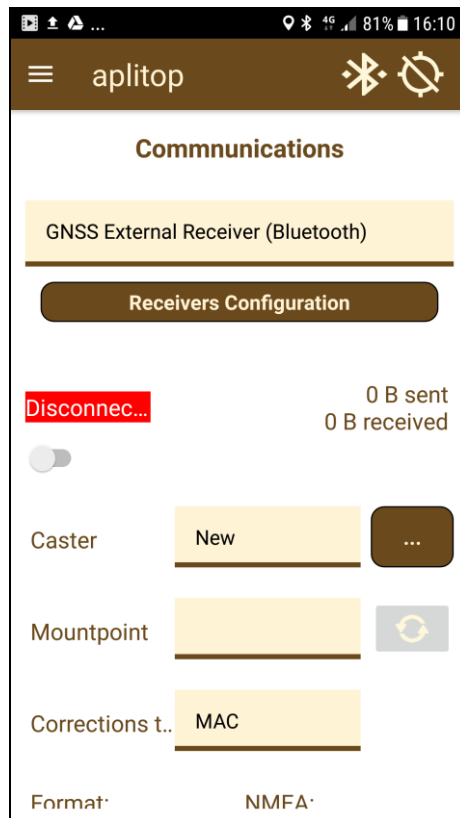
Setting up TcpGPS for working with TERIA network in NTRIP mode.

### Details

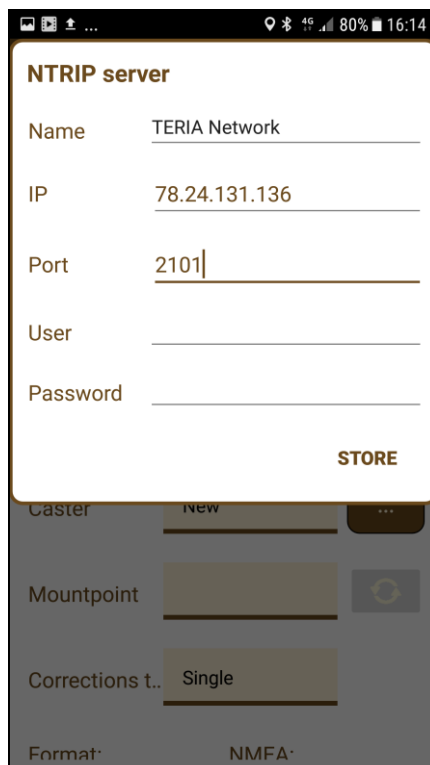
- Go to **Application > Communications** within the main menu.



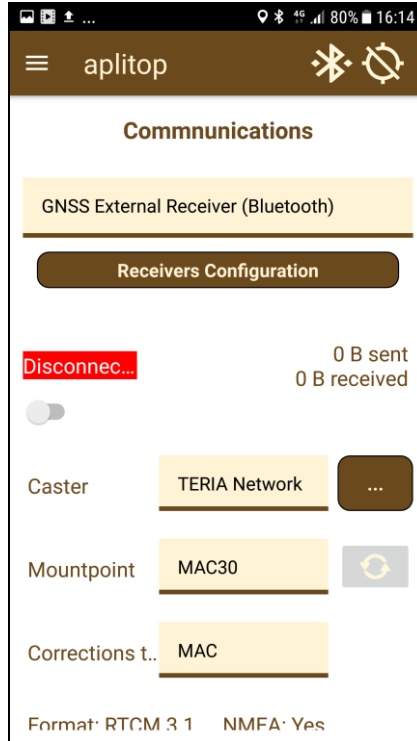
- Select **New** from the **Caster** list and tap on the button on the right.



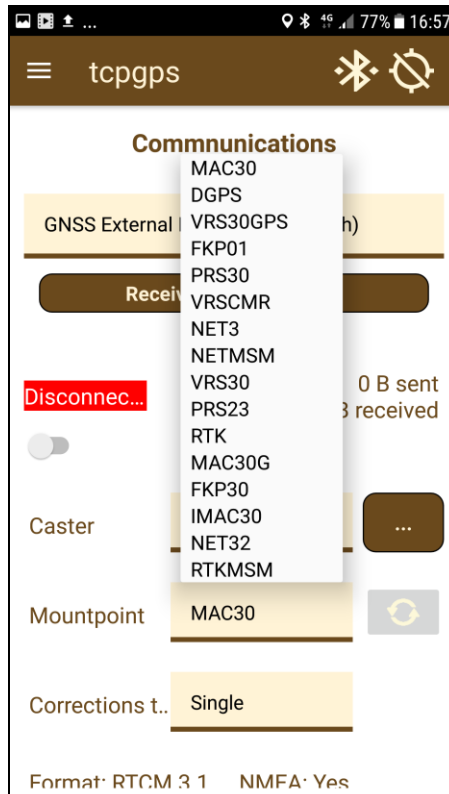
- Enter the **IP**, **Port**, **User** and **Password** for TERIA NTRIP network and tap on **Store**.



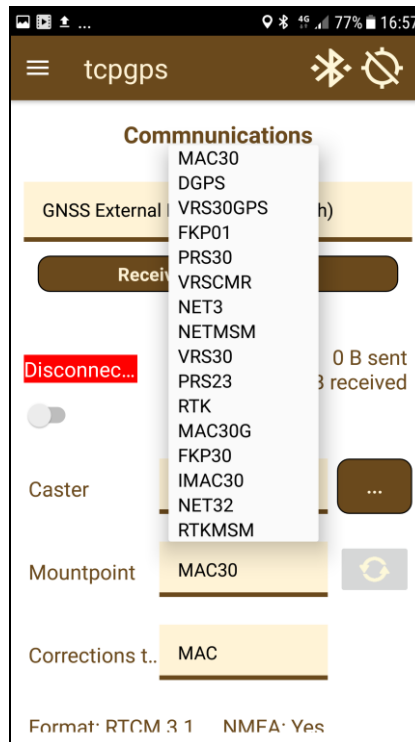
- Select the new profile created for TERIA network form the **Caster** list.



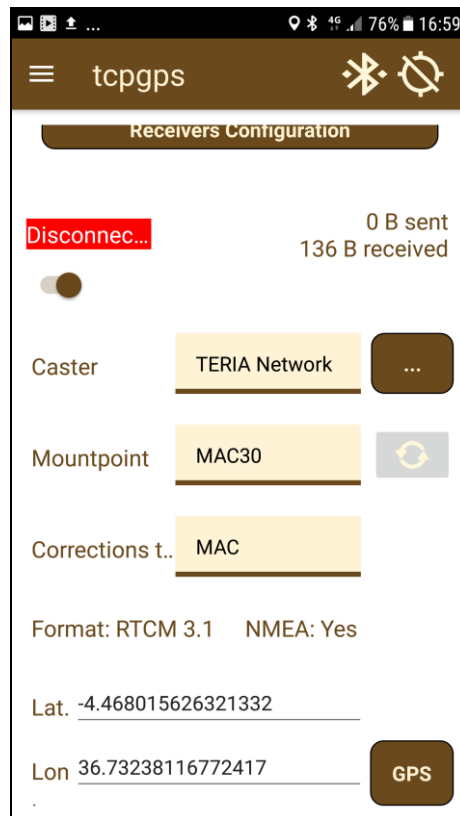
- Select the mount point from **Mountpoint** list.



- Select the type of corrections from the **Corrections** list. In some cases, such as Spectra SP60, this parameter is not needed.



- Measure from GPS the current position, if NMEAGGA is needed.



- Connect to the TERIA NTRIP server tapping on the top-left button.
